Effectiveness Study results: Frank-Hermann et al 2007

A study with a total of 17638 cycles. All women included stayed part of the study for at least 13 cycles, were at the learning stage of learning the Sympto-Thermal Method and under guidance from an instructor.

Inclusion criteria

- Age 19-45
- Cycle length 22-35 (20% deviation allowed)
- Willing to record pregnancy intention before each cycle
- Willing to record all sexual behaviour (intercourse, genital contact, withdrawal, occasional barrier use)
- Agreement not to use any other contraception
- No known history of sub-fertility / infertility
- Established LP of at least 10 days
- At least 3 months following breastfeeding, oral contraception, post-partum, post-abortum
- Willing to participate for 12 months

Exclusion criteria

- Pregnancy achieving at study entry
- Post-pill
- Irregular cycles (>35 days)
- Post-partum / breastfeeding
- Experienced Users
- Premenopausal women over 45
- No sexual partner
- Younger women under 19
- Post-abortum
